



ELEPHANT

ALIZE PUFFY

COLOR: 416 GRAY

BALL OF YARN: 4

DIFFICULTY: EASY

MATTRESS PART: Open up the first stitch in Puffy 416 gray yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the back of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 3: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROW 4: Pick up 2 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROW 5: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. ROW 6: Work as the Row 4. ROW 7: Work as the Row 5. ROW 8: Work as the Row 4. ROWS 9 to 13: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. ROW 14: For the mattress underside; start decreasing the stitches. For this, pass 1 stitch coming from the ball behind 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 2 stitches singly. ROW 15: Work as the Row 5. ROW 16: Work as the Row 14. ROW 17: Work as the Row 5. ROW 18: Work as the Row 14. After this row, fill the mattress w/ fiber filling material. ROW 19: Work as the Row 5. ROW 20: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball behind 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROWS 21 to 24: Decrease stitches by passing 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession until one stitch remains. Open up next 2 stitches coming from the ball, lock and fix it passing through the last remaining stitch.

ELEPHANT HEAD: Start working at the trunk for the elephant head. For this, open up the first stitch in Puffy 416 gray yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 5th stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. Starting on the 2nd row, pick up stitches behind stitches on all rows. ROWS 2 to 12: Pick up single stitches from each stitch and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. On the last row, form the trunk filling with fiber material. ROW 13: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the back of stitches. ROWS 14 to 16: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROWS 17 to 18: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROWS 19 to 22: For closing the top, start decreasing the stitches. For this, pass 1 stitch coming from the ball behind 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROW 23: Decrease stitches by passing 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession. Decrease all the stitches in the same way and bind off the stitches. Open up next 2 stitches coming from the ball, fix it by passing and gathering behind the last remaining stitch.

EARS: Count 7 stitches from Puffy 416 gray yarn and bind off the stitches. Apply binding off on every row. ROWS 2 to 6: Pick up 2 stitches from the first stitch on one side of knitting, and one stitch from the last stitch on the other side. Bind off the stitches on the last row and finish. Work another ear in the same way. Pick up stitches from the edge of worked ears not increased and pass them at the side of head (as in image) and bind off the stitches. Affix the other ear to the head in the same way.

EYES: Make 4 chains w/ the black yarn. Join chains to form a circle. Work 12 fake single crochets inside the circle formed and finish. Make another eye in the same way.



RABBIT

ALİZE PUFFY

COLOR: 55 WHITE

BALL OF YARN: 3

COLOR: 31 BABY PINK

BALL OF YARN: 1

HEAD & BODY: Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 3: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. ROW 4: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROWS 5 to 9: Pick up 2 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROWS 10 to 13: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. ROW 14: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 2 stitches singly. ROW 15: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. Starting filling with fiber material. Go on with the body part. ROWS 16 and 17: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. ROWS 18 and 19: Pick up 2 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROWS 20 and 21: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. ROWS 22 and 23: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 2 stitches singly. ROWS 24 and 25: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. Decrease the stitches until one stitch remains. **ARMS:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 3: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROW 4: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROW 5: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROWS 6 to 13: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Pass the stitches on the last row to the sides of body part and bind off the stitches. Work the other arm in the same way. **LEGS:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 3: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROW 4: Pick up 2 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROW 5: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 2 stitches singly. ROW 6: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. Starting filling with fiber material. ROWS 7 to 18: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Pass the stitches on the last row to the sides of body part and bind off the stitches. Work the other leg in the same way. **EARS:** Pick up 3 stitches at the sides of upper head w/ the baby pink yarn and bind off the stitches. ROWS 2 to 5: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches, and bind them off. ROW 6: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROW 7: Get the remaining stitches together and finish. Work the other ear in the same way. In order to have smooth appearance around ears, pick up stitches around them w/ the white yarn and bind off the stitches. For the pink part on the belly of rabbit, start with 4 stitches w/ the pink yarn. Work 5 rows in the same way, and pick up stitches on the last row and bind off the stitches. Sew it on the belly of rabbit.

MONKEY

ALIZE PUFFY

COLOR: 310 HONEY BUBBLE

BALL OF YARN: 3

COLOR: 55 WHITE

BALL OF YARN: 1

DIFFICULTY: EASY

HEAD: Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROWS 2 to 3: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 4: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROW 5: Open up the first stitch of the 310 honey bubble ball and tie it. As of this row, start working w/ this color. Pick up 3 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROWS 6 to 9: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROWS 10 to 12: For closing the top, start decreasing the stitches. For this, pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROW 13: Decrease stitches by passing 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession. Decrease all the stitches in the same way and bind off the stitches. Open up next 2 stitches coming from the ball; fix it by passing and gathering in front of the last remaining stitch. **BODY:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROWS 2 to 3: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 4: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROW 5: Pick up 2 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROW 6: Open up the first stitch of the 310 honey bubble ball and tie it. As of this row, start working w/ this color. Pick up 3 single and 1 double stitches from stitches. ROWS 7 to 11: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROWS 12 to 14: For closing up the body, start decreasing the stitches. For this, pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROW 15: Decrease stitches by passing 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession. Decrease all the stitches in the same way and bind off the stitches. Open up next 2 stitches coming from the ball; fix it by passing and gathering in front of the last remaining stitch. **ARMS:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROWS 3 to 4: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROW 5: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROWS 6 to 17: Open up the first stitch of the 310 honey bubble ball and tie it. As of this row, start working w/ this color. Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Pass the stitches on the last row to the sides of body part (as in the image) and bind off the stitches. Work the other arm in the same way. **LEGS:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROWS 2 to 3: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROWS 4 to 7: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Open up the first stitch of the 310 honey bubble ball and tie it. As of this row, start working w/ this color. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROW 8: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. ROWS 9 to 18: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Pass the stitches on the last row to the sides of lower body part (as in the image) and bind off the stitches. Work the other leg in the same way. **TAIL:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 310 honey bubble yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROW 3: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROWS 4 to 23: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. Pass the stitches on the last row to the back of body part (as in the image) and bind off the stitches. **EARS:** Pick up 3 stitches at the sides of upper head and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches, and bind them off. Work the other ear in the same way and pick up stitches around two ears and bind off the stitches. **NOSE:** Open up the first stitch in Puffy 55 white yarn; tie the obtained yarn next to the 3rd stitch to have a circle and bind off the stitches. ROW 2: Pick up two stitches from each stitch from the front of stitches, and bind off the picked ones. Apply binding off on every row. ROWS 3 to 4: Pick up 1 single and 1 double stitch from stitches. ROWS 5 to 6: Pick up stitches one by one from other stitches. Starting on this row, give form by filling with fiber material. ROW 7: Pass 1 stitch coming from the ball in front of 2 stitches in succession, and pick up 1 stitch singly. Pass the stitches on the last row to the middle part of face (as in the image) and bind off the stitches.
